RULES

1. The adjudicators' decision will be final.
2. Entries will be taken on day of feis and will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with "An Coimisiun Le Rince Gaelacha".
3. Age will be reckoned from the 1st January 2015.
4. Objections must be submitted in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of that particular competition and accompanied by a fee of £20.00.
5. There is no smoking permitted in the hall and we would ask that all attending respect the venue.
6. An Comhairle ruling: All Bun Grád and Tus Grád competitors must wear a class costume or a simple skirt/top. It is not permissible to wear tan or make-up in these grades up to and including under 12.
7. Bun Grád and Tus Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize in that particular dance in any age or grade. (Bun Grád: basic steps only).
8. Mean Grád is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance or age group in either Méan or Árd Grad.
9. For Child Protection purposes the CLRG does not allow any form of unauthorized photography which has the ability to capture a child/dancer's image whilst in motion.
10. Effective from September 2005, no block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group.
11. Effective from 1st March 2014 make-up and false eyelashes are not permitted for dancers in either solo or team competitions up to and including the under 10.
12. Effective from 1st January 2015. For heavy rounds in competitions, dancers may not wear soft shoes that have been altered with the addition of heels and tips in an attempt to turn them into hard shoes. Dancers found to be wearing such altered shoes for heavy rounds may be denied access to that round of the competition.
13. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
14. In Ard Grad championships cups and sashes will be presented to winners from 1st to 5th place & in Pre-lim cups and sashes will be presented to winners from 1st to 3rd place.
15. There will be a separate male competition if there are more than 5 boys entered in championships 7-8 and upwards.
