I enclose:

1. A proposed syllabus in Irish and English timetabled for all ages and grades.
2. Feis/Féile rules
3. Appropriate registration fee: 1 day / 1 platform = £50 sterling or €60 euro. A cost of £30 sterling or €36 euro per day per platform for all additional competitions will be charged. Cheques/bank drafts made out to An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha are the accepted payment method.
4. A sketch of halls and platforms, with dimensions and showing layout of seating and dancing area and also position of adjudicators.
5. An Cúige Uladh requires a copy of public liability insurance certificate and employer's certificate for all events registered with An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha.
6. An Cúige Uladh requires three copies of the proposed syllabus along with fully completed registration form. One of these must be signed by a member of An Cúige Uladh before the syllabus can be issued for general release.
7. From 15th September 2013, any Adjudicator who judges a Feis or grade exams in Ulster may not judge any Feis in the Ulster region for a further 6 months.
8. An Cúige Uladh will only allow 32 competitions, non-championship/premier competitions maximum to be held on any one day; this may be increased by special application to An Cúige Uladh.
9. An Cúige Uladh has now set the minimum number of bars of music required. Reels and jigs = 40 bars, Bun grad reel, slip jig, hornpipe = 32 bars for solo competition.
10. The minimum metronomic speeds for Tus grad are as follows: reel = 120, light jig = 115, single jig = 120, slip jig = 120, heavy jig = 82, hornpipe = 130. Speeds for Bun Grad reels are now required to be 122 - 124.
11. An Cúige Uladh requires organisers to show and certify that profits have been donated to the beneficiary stated on the application form.
12. An Cúige Uladh requires feis organisers to finish each days programme by 10 p.m.
13. Results of all grades, including championships must be submitted to feis registrar **no more than one month after each feis.** This must include at least the 1st place and any upgraded dancers. Failure to do so may affect registration of future feiseanna.
14. Bun grad and Tus grad competitions are confined to residents in Ulster plus any counties that border the county in which the feis is to be held.
15. In Bun grad and Tus grad, make-up is not permitted and dancers must wear either class costume or "day" clothes.
16. It is recommended that prior to the feis date, feis organisers should agree with adjudicators and musicians either verbally or in written form a daily fee to be paid and a currency in which the fee will be paid. Terms of breaks/lunches/overtime etc. should also be agreed prior to the event.
