BUNGRAD – Reel, Single Jig, Light Jig, Light Trophy Dance

TUS GRAD – Reel, Single Jig, Slip Jig, Light Jig, Heavy Jig, Light Trophy Dance

MEANGRAD – Reel, Single/Slip Jig, Light/Heavy Jig, Hornpipe, Light Trophy, Heavy Trophy, Tad Set

(Please note there will be no Hornpipe competition U6 & U7 years)

ENTRY FEE

All entries on the day. Solo Entry £3 / Trophy Dance £5

A sash & small riser trophy will be awarded for 1st place in each Trophy Dance.

RULES

1. The adjudicators decision is final
2. Entries will be taken on day of feis
3. Objections must be submitted in writing within one hour of the announcement of results of that competition & accompanied by a fee of £20
4. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis
5. Age reckoned from 1st January 2015
6. All Bungrad & Tusgrad competitors must wear a class costume or appropriate day wear. They are not permitted to wear fake tan or make-up in these grades up to u12 years. Bungrad dancers must also dance basic steps
7. Bungrad & Tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won first prize in that particular dance in any age or grade
8. Meangrad is confined to dancers who have never won 1st place for that particular dance or age group either in Mean or Ard grad
9. No child dancing in age groups up to & including u10years is permitted to wear tan/make up in any grade, as per An Coimisiun rule
10. For child protection purposes the organisation does not allow any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a child/dancers image whilst in motion
11. No block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to & including u12 age group.
