Conveniently located just off the M1, our central venue is situated 20 minutes from Armagh, 40 minutes from Belfast, and 60 minutes from Derry, Dundalk and Enniskillen to name a few. BUN GRÁD DANCES

Reel, Single Jig, Light Jig, Light Trophy Dance (any listed Bun Grád dance)

TÚS GRÁD DANCES

Reel, Single Jig, Light Jig, Slip Jig, Light Trophy Dance (any listed Tús Grád dance)

MEAN GRÁD DANCES

Reel, Single Jig, Slip Jig, Light Trophy Dance (any listed Mean Grád dance)
Heavy Jig, Hornpipe, Traditional Set Dance (any of the seven traditional set dances)

All dancers will be placed in the Reel and Trophy Dance competitions. All grade dance winners will receive a riser. Top 5 in the trophy dance will receive trophies.

UNDER 5 CHAMPIONSHIP: Reel & Single Jig or Light Jig
UNDER 6 CHAMPIONSHIP: Reel, Single Jig & Light/Heavy Jig
UNDER 7 CHAMPIONSHIP: Reel, Single Jig & Light/Heavy Jig

All dancers in these championships will receive a solo placing in each round and an overall championship result. Solo result winners will receive a riser. Top 5 in the championship will receive trophies.

FEIS RULES

COMPETITION RULES

1. The adjudicator's decision is final.
2. Age taken as at 1st January 2019.
3. Entries only accepted from teachers registered with An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha.
4. Competitions are open to dancers from any region worldwide.
5. No refunds.
6. In Bun Grád and Tús Grád, up to and including under 12, make-up and tan is not permitted. In Mean Grád, Prelim and Open Championships, up to and including under 10, make-up and tan is not permitted.
7. In Bun Grád and Tús Grád, dancers may only wear class costume or day clothes. No solo costumes are permitted.
8. Bun Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place, or have been re-graded, in that particular dance in any grade or age. Basic steps must be performed.
9. Tús Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place, or have been re-graded, in that particular dance in Tús Grád or higher.
10. Mean Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in Mean Grád or higher.
11. To be eligible for the Prelim Championship, dancers must never (a) previously won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators, (b) never previously won more than three preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudicators and (c) not have qualified for the World Championships in either the current or previous year.
12. No block/en point (stationary or moving) will be allowed for all ages up to and including Under 11.
13. Dances permitted in Traditional Set Dance are: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journey Work, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Three Sea Captains or Jockey to the Fair.
14. Music will be played at the following speeds:
Bun Grád: Reel 122-124, Single Jig 124, Light Jig 116.
Tús Grád: Reel 116-118, Single Jig 124, Light Jig 116, Slip Jig 120, Heavy Jig 82.
Mean Grád, Prelim & Open: Reel 113, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 113, Heavy Jig 73, Hornpipe 113.
Traditional Set Dances: Blackbird 144, St. Patrick's Day 94, Job of Journeywork 138, Garden of Daisies 138, King of the Fairies 130, Three Sea Captains 96, Jockey To The Fair 90.
15. Dancers will be re-graded as follows: 5-30 competitors - 1 dancer re-graded, 31-50 competitors - 2 dancers re-graded, 51+ competitors - 3 dancers re-graded. All re-graded dancers will receive a trophy as per first place.

OTHER RULES

16. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, with or without flash enhancement, is strictly prohibited. Photography is permitted during results.
17. Any parent who would not like their child to appear in photos taken by the feis committee should make the feis organiser aware prior to results being announced.
18. Any objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of result, accompanied by fee of £20.00.
19. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
20. The feis committee reserves the right to transfer competitions/results to a different stage or to alternate competitions if it becomes necessary in order to help the feis run smoothly. The committee reserves the right to use a relief adjudicator.
21. The feis committee reserve the right to refuse feis entries or entrance into the feis.
